

Errors in the IIFT 2006 Paper

1. Qs 24 in Set A, Qs 18 in Set B, Qs 86 in Set C, Qs 82 in Set D

The Question reads like " Which of the following is obtained after rationalization of the expression... .."

Both the options (A) and (D) are actually same, and that is the right answer. But this question should have only one correct answer.

2. Qs 28 in Set A, Qs 14 in Set B, Qs 77 in Set C, Qs 74 in Set D

The Question reads like " In the right-angled triangle QPR given below, PS is the altitude to the hypotenuse. The figure is followed by three possible inferences.... .."

None of the options are correct. Right answer should be "I and III are correct".

3. Qs 37 in Set A, Qs 24 in Set B, Qs 81 in Set C, Qs 70 in Set D

The Question reads like " The domain of definition of the function $y=...$.."

None of the options are correct. Right answer should be " $[7, 3) \cup \{2\}$ ".

4. Qs 33 in Set A, Qs 33 in Set B, Qs 90 in Set C, Qs 78 in Set D

The Question reads like " Pavan builds an overhead tank in his house. Which has.... .."

In the second and third line of the question, it is mentioned that " ... the second one takes one and a half times more than the first one to fill it... .."

Logical interpretation should be, first pipe takes 12 hours and the second pipe takes 30 hours. If the second pipe takes 30 hours to fill up the tank, then None of the options are correct.

However, if we take that the second pipe takes only 18 hours to fill up the tank, then option (B) is correct. But logically, going by the language, we should not interpret it in that way.

5. Qs 48 in Set A, Qs 9 in Set B, Qs 98 in Set C, Qs 56 in Set D

The Question reads like " Madan is going from Mumbai to Delhi in order to... .."

In 7th and 8th line it is mentioned that " ..he packed the metal box from outside with wallpaper costing.... .."

One cannot pack some solid object from outside, the correct language should have been "covered" or "wrapped". Even if we take the meaning as "covered or "wrapped", we never know that the wallpaper had some overlap during 'packing'; hence we are not sure about the area of the wallpaper used.

Also in option (C), they have mentioned, "The area of any one side of the metal box is 196 sq. cm.". But side is an one dimensional figure, how it can be measured in sq cm?

6. Qs 49 in Set A, Qs 10 in Set B, Qs 97 in Set C, Qs 57 in Set D

The Question reads like " Ranjan goes to a countryside lake for a boat ride... .."

It should have been given that water of the lake is still. But in the second line they have used the word 'downstream', which leads the aspirants to more confusion about the fact whether the water is flowing or not!

7. Qs 50 in Set A, Qs 1 in Set B, Qs 99 in Set C, Qs 60 in Set D

The Question reads like " Vijay has been invited for a dinner in a club... .."

1. The questions talks about building but in options (A) and (C), they are mentioning about 'tower'. Are the 'building' and the 'tower' same? If they are not same, then none of the options are correct.
